



Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) Grant Program FY 2012



The TMDL grant program, established in Minnesota Statutes Section 446A.073, provides grants to governmental units to assist with the cost of wastewater treatment or stormwater projects necessary to meet wasteload reduction requirements under Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) implementation plans prepared and approved under Section 303(d) of the federal Clean Water Act. The TMDL grant program provides grants for 50% of eligible costs up to a maximum of \$3,000,000. The Public Facilities Authority (PFA) is responsible for the financial administration of the program. Projects must be listed on the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency's (MPCA) Project Priority List (PPL) and eligible as-bid costs must be certified by the MPCA prior to grant award. Grants will be awarded based on the estimated cost in the application or the as-bid cost, whichever is less. The determination of eligible costs will include a calculation by the MPCA of the Essential Project Component percentage based on existing versus future needs, which may result in some projects qualifying for less than 50% grants.

A total of \$23,851,028 is available for TMDL grants in FY 2012, including funds appropriated by the Minnesota Legislature from the Clean Water Legacy Fund. In accordance with program statutes, the PFA accepted new TMDL grant applications in July 2011. TMDL grant applications are listed below, starting with remaining FY11 applications that were certified by the MPCA by June 30, 2011, and continuing with FY12 applications in priority order based on the MPCA's 2012 PPL. Applications shown with no grant amount have been determined to be not eligible for a TMDL grant or not able to proceed with the project in FY 2012. To receive a TMDL grant in FY 2012, the applicant must submit its as-bid construction costs and receive MPCA project certification by June 30, 2012. Shaded lines indicate FY 2012 grants that have been awarded to date. The PFA expects to have sufficient funds to award TMDL grants to all eligible applicants that receive MPCA project certification by June 30, 2012.
